Eligibility for this scholarship is determined by the following criteria. You must:

- Have attended school in Berlin or Boylston for at least **one** full school year during your education.
- Have received Special Education services at some point in your education in Berlin or Boylston school(s).
- Be a graduating Assabet Valley Technical High School or Tahanto Regional Middle High School student who will be continuing their education at a university, college or vocational institution in the next academic year.

Requirement: Please write an essay (250 – 500 words) on **one** of the following topics:

OR

Who or what from your education in the Berlin/Boylston Public Schools has prepared you to continue your education and how has that happened?
